

The **Department for African Studies, University of Cologne**, offers a position (starting 1.7.2013 or later) at the level of

post-doc lecturer/researcher (fixed-term)
for initially 2 years, German salary scale 13 TV-L.

The position is full-time (39.83 hours/week), a split into two part-time positions (19.92 hours/week) is in principle possible.

The position involves participation in the teaching and research programme of the cultural anthropology of Africa. Successful applicants will have to have a PhD degree in African Studies, Anthropology or a closely related field and long-term ethnographic field research experience relating to Africa. The position is open to graduates regardless of nationality. We expect applicants to be prepared to start learning German if they do not already have the appropriate language skills.

Applicants with disabilities will be given preferential treatment provided equal qualification and capability.
