3. Likopano za litaba za naha halina kulumelelwa ku ba ni mukopano, kucaula kapa kuezwa liponiso bukaufi ni mukopano wa kopano yefwi kanako ye swana mwa lizazi lilifwi.
4. Likopano, halina kulumelelwa kusebelisa mikwa ya lizibiso ze belwe mwa sibaka kapa ze zamaya mwa limota mwahala linaqo za 21:00 ni 07:00 ze kona kuezwa litata kwa sicaba.
5. Babuleli kwa mukopano habasikalumelelwi ku sebelisa manzwi a susuza mifilifili ku mutu kapa kwa sikwata sa babafwi. Likopano lhaniswa kubonahaza mapampili, kapa mahoto a susuza mifilifili.
6. Limembala za kopano ni bayemeli ba yona habasika lumelelwa kusinya mikopano ya babafwi, kucaula kapa liponiso za kopano yefwi.
7. Limembala za kopano ni bayemeli ba yona habasika lumelelwa kuanisa babafwi kuya kwa mikopano ya likopano zefwi.
8. Limembala za kopano ni bayemeli ba yona habasika lumelelwa kusinya kapa kushandaula mapampili a lizibiso za likopano zefwi.
9. Baeteleli ba likopano ba ka sebelisa maofisi a bona
10. Kulumelela likopano zefwi kuya mwa libaka za baketi, kungelela cwalo mwa libaka za baketi baba funaneha mwa masimu ni mwa libaka ze luwile ki mutuso, kasamulaho wa lithola za kusebaza.
11. Likopano lika buga mikwa ya kuambola ni likopano zefwi kwa maofisi a bona a matana; ni mwa likaliso za likisi ni lilalanda, ni kuketa muongo-ngi ya ka bizwa nako kaufela kutobona butata bu bobu ka batefi.
12. Muzamaisi wa Liketisa u ka ikopanya ni bayemeli ba likopano viki ni viki kuambola litaba ze ama lizibiso za liketisa ni liketisa cwalo. Mikopano ya putako ika ezahala ha kutowahala cwalo.

16. Liluko la Liketisa ni baeteleli ba likopano balumeta kuzibahaza Milao ya Buiswalwe ye mwa Namibia kaufela sa mikwa fi ni li ye ba na ni yona.
17. Likopano li ka bona kuli mwa misebezi ya zona ya kuzibahaza liketisa ni kulelelwa batu ku li yemeta halina kusinya sibaka mo li sebeleza.

The Namibian presidential and parliamentary elections on 27 November 2019 seem to generate little interest amongst the electorate. Are there no issues at stake, has the social justice and social welfare landscape improved to the benefit of many? In this seminar we join land activist and political scientist Job Amupanda, political studies professor Lesley Blaauw and veteran political analyst Andre du Pisani, all from the University of Namibia, in an open discussion on the forthcoming elections. Their presence in Basel is a timely opportunity to enhance our understanding and discuss developments beyond the elections and of more paradigmatic relevance for the whole of southern Africa.
